Performers will stay with their Buddy & Chaperone at all times.

This includes time in and out of all events, common space at the hotel, eating, traveling on city transportation, on the street, etc. You are with your buddy AT ALL TIMES from the beginning to the end of the trip. I understand this rule/expectation: ______ (performer initials)

Performers are not allowed in other people's hotel rooms.

At NO TIME should anyone be in someone else's hotel room. <u>No exceptions!</u> You are not allowed in anyone's room except your own. This includes chaperone's rooms. I understand this rule/expectation: ______

Performers must be in their rooms at "Room Check" and be tucked in at "Lights Out".

This is an action packed trip. Everyone needs their sleep. We don't want cranky teenagers or adults. Everyone needs their energy for long days at the parks. I understand this rule/expectation: _____

Performers must not leave the building, designated area, event, space, etc. that the group is visiting. This includes traveling on public transportation, Uber, Lyft, taxi, the EL, or another other form of transportation.

Performers will be ON-TIME for "check-in" with their chaperones and directors.

Performers must physically be at all check-in times. Even if this means you must get out of a shopping/food line, you must be on time for the check-in. Texting to say you will be late is not acceptable. You must be there, in person and on time. I understand this rule/expectation: _____

Performers will not display any types of PDA while on this trip.

This includes but is not limited to: hand holding, kissing, snuggling, laying/resting on each other, etc. I understand this rule/expectation: _____

Attire will be appropriate and represent yourself and your directors in a positive

way. No short shorts, low cut tops, clothing with vulgar or suggestive sayings. <u>NO SHORT SHORTS!</u> I understand this rule/expectation: _____

There will be no tobacco, alcohol, foul language or roughhousing while on this trip. I understand this rule/expectation: _____

Performers will (and will be reminded to) call home each night between "Room Check" and "Light's Out".

Your parents love you and want to hear about your day. You will be descriptive and tell them about your adventures. Be kind and loving. I understand this rule/expectation: _____

Violations:

Violations of any of the above rules/expectations will result in disciplinary action by seen fit by the directors. Should we feel that something is becoming a concern, we will contact the parents. Our goal is to keep everyone safe, healthy and responsible for their decisions. Shortly following that, our goal is to encourage everyone to have a great time!

Various examples of consequences:

- Tardiness: 30 minutes early to the next check in
- Foul Language/Roughhousing/ Inappropriate beh: Becoming day-long buddies with Miss Jennifer
- Alcohol/Tobacco/Drugs: Sent home immediately at parent's expense/parent is responsible for coming to get them/parent pays for security to "babysit" the performer at the hotel for the duration of the trip/parent arranges for performer to ride Greyhound bus back to Omaha.
